

Status Update: Foundry Remediation
August 5, 2020

**I. New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC)
Neighborhood Remediation Update**

Remedial Design

- Design drawings were completed for four properties on Goodelle Terrace that NYSDEC anticipates will be cleaned up during 2021.
- Remedial designs are in progress for Genesee Park and for two properties on the west side of Genesee Street opposite the park. NYSDEC's contractor will meet with City officials later this week to review plans for the park. NYSDEC anticipates cleanup activities will be performed at these properties beginning later this year.
- NYSDEC's contractor met with the owners of four properties on the east side of Wadsworth Street, north of Pepsi Lane. NYSDEC anticipates cleanup activities will be performed at these properties beginning in September or October.
- Soil sampling will be conducted from mid- to late August at 28 properties along Exchange, Wadsworth, and Middle Streets.

Remedial Construction

- NYSDEC's contractor conducted additional restoration activities at properties along the east side of Genesee Street north of Genesee Park, and at the Genesee Park Place properties.
- Excavation and backfilling activities were completed at two properties on the north side of Lewis Street. Restoration activities have begun at these properties.
- Excavation and backfilling activities will be conducted at additional properties along the north side of Lewis Street during the month of August.
- Landscaping items were installed at additional properties on Genesee Street and Lafayette Avenue that were remediated in 2019. Additional properties will be completed this month.

II. City Foundry Site Remediation

Foundry remediation and restoration is complete. Some additional releveling of the area and overgrowth maintenance will be monitored and handled.

III. Resident outreach – City of Geneva

FoodLink Curbside's mobile market for fresh vegetables and fruits is operating with strict COVID-19 guidelines at the Salvation Army from 11:15 AM to 12:30 PM, Elmcrest Apartments 3:15 PM to 4:15 PM, and Seneca Street Apartments 1:45 PM to 2:45 PM. The Farmer's Market voucher program is available at the Wednesday market from 3:00 to 7:00 PM. Voucher program for the Dog Park is available again for residents waiting for remediation.
